GENERAL CONDITIONS OF SALE

TO BE READ BY THE AUCTIONEER BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE SALE

1. **THE SALE IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE PAYMENT OF VALUE ADDED TAX (VAT).**
2. The right of admission is reserved.
3. **THE STATE SHALL, AT ANY TIME, HAVE THE RIGHT TO STOP THE AUCTION, OR TO WITHDRAW A LOT, OR LOTS, OR PART OF A LOT OR LOTS, WITHOUT PROVIDING ANY REASONS.**
4. The buyer shall be the highest bidder. Should any dispute arise between two or more bidders, the lot or lots shall be put up again for auction and resold; or the auctioneer may, after consultation with the Departmental representative, declare the buyer.
 - 4.1 Lots may be grouped and any lot may be divided at the discretion of the Departmental representative, provided the buyers have no objection.
 - 4.2 The order or sequence in which the lots will be sold may be changed only at the discretion of the Departmental representative, providing that the buyers have no objection.
5. The Departmental representative at the auction shall have the right, if necessary, to stop the auction or withdraw any lot or lots if satisfactory prices are not obtained or sell any lot or lots provisionally, subject to confirmation within 14 days.
6. Treasury will only accept payment in the form of electronic funds transfers. The State reserves the right to demand payment from a buyer once the bid has been knocked-down to him/her.

****A "SPEED-POINT" WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR PAYMENT, BUYERS JUST NEED TO ADJUST THEIR TRANSACTION AMOUNTS PRIOR TO THE AUCTION PAYMENT.****
- 7.1 As soon as a lot has been knocked-down, ownership and risk shall pass to the buyer and no complaints will be considered thereafter. The full amount payable must be cleared on the DARDEA bank statement by 29 July 2026, otherwise the purchase will be deemed to be forfeited.
- 7.2 **R20 000.00** for deposit is **COMPULSORY** for **ALL** buyers. If the full purchase amount is not paid by 29 July 2026, the deposit as well as the purchase will be forfeited.
8. The bidder is responsible for the full payment of the lot or lots that was/were knocked down to him/her by the auctioneer
9. Should the purchaser fail to pay the purchase price, the Government shall be entitled at its discretion to:
 - 9.1 Claim from the purchaser interest at the maximum allowable rate calculated from the date of purchase to date of payment; and/or
 - 9.2 Repossess the assets in order to resell at the risk of the defaulting purchaser who shall be liable for all costs involved with the resale and for any damage incurred by the State. The purchaser will not be entitled to any profit that may arise from the resale; or
 - 9.3 Institute legal proceedings for the payment of the amount owed or for the return of the assets in which event the conditions of clause 12.2 apply; and
 - 9.4 Recover any legal costs calculated at the Attorney/Client tariff as well as all collection costs.
10. Buyers are not permitted to enter into any transaction on Government premises for the resale of any goods purchased at the auction.
- 11.. Buyers or their representative must be present to supervise the loading of their lot or lots and it must be clearly understood that no complaints will be considered after such lot or lots are loaded and an official receipt for such game has been signed by the buyer or his/her representative.
12. The Government is responsible for providing assistance with the loading of the animals but not for the removal thereof.
13. Buyers, their representatives and workers, their vehicles and equipment, enter any and all Government premises at their own risk, and the department assumes no responsibility for their safety or the safety of their property.
14. **RESERVE PRICES ARE APPLICABLE TO ALL LOTS OFFERED FOR SALE**
15. Invoices shall not be split between buyers nor will any invoice be altered **IN ANY MANNER** once the bid have been knocked down to him/her by the auctioneer.
16. Buyers will only receive an invoice when they have bid on the Auction.



CONDITIONS OF SALE: HUNTING LOTS AND HUNTING RULES FOR FREE STATE PROVINCIAL NATURE RESERVES

- 1 In the context of these rules;
 - Nature Reserve / Reserve - refers to any Free State Provincial Nature Reserve managed by the Department of Agriculture, Rural Development and Environmental Affairs (DARDEA).
 - Hunt / hunting / hunted - refers to the physical killing of an animal.
 - A **NON-TROPHY ANIMAL** is defined as an animal not generally hunted for its trophy and includes young males and both young and adult females of the species.
 - A **TROPHY ANIMAL** is defined as an **ADULT ANIMAL, REPRESENTATIVE OF ITS SPECIES**, but qualification for any trophy record system is neither guaranteed nor implied.
- 2 The **SPECIFIC CONTENT OF THE HUNT PACKAGE DESCRIPTION IS NON-NEGOTIABLE**. This includes the species and gender of the animals, the allocated dates of the hunt and the maximum number of hunters permitted per package.
- 3 Only South African citizens may hunt those packages designated as non-trophy hunts and proof of identification must be presented, by the hunter/s prior to the commencement of such hunt.
- 4 Any Professional Hunter accompanying a foreign client/s on a hunt in any Nature Reserve must be fully registered in the Free State province and proof of such registration (Valid PH Permit) must be presented prior to the commencement of the hunt.
- 5 All hunters must be in possession of a **VALID FREE STATE PROVINCE HUNTING LICENCE**.
- 6 Prior to the commencement of any hunt, hunters are expected to register at the specific reserve's administration office. Hunters must provide the **ORIGINAL RECEIPTS** validating the **FULL PAYMENT** of the purchase price of the hunt package as well as proof of identification.
- 7 Where applicable, hunters must also provide valid proof that they have obtained the written permission of the purchaser to hunt in their stead.
- 8 The **CONSUMPTION OF ANY ALCOHOL PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF, OR DURING, ANY HUNT IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED**. Hunters or other members of the hunting party are also not permitted to carry any alcohol with them during any hunt. No hunting will take place if any hunter is under the influence of alcohol, or considered by the officiating reserve representative to be under the influence of alcohol or if any alcohol is conveyed on the vehicle during a hunt.
- 9 Animals larger in size than a Blesbuck may only be hunted with a firearm of **6,5MM CALIBRE**, or larger.
- 10 Dangerous game (Buffalo) may only be hunted with a firearm of **9.3 MM OR .375 CALIBRE**, or larger.

**CONDITIONS OF SALE: HUNTING LOTS AND
HUNTING RULES FOR FREE STATE PROVINCIAL NATURE RESERVES**

- 11** **NO SOLID POINT AMMUNITION MAY BE USED FOR THE HUNTING OF ANY ANIMALS**, with the exception of Buffalo, however, the use of monolithic-hollow point type **HUNTING BULLETS** may be permitted at the discretion of the Reserve Manager.
- 12** **NO AUTOMATIC OR SEMI-AUTOMATIC RIFLES** may be used for hunting. It is permissible to hunt with a bow, but the hunting of any animal with an arrow tipped with poison or any drug is not permitted. The draw weight of the bow and the weight and type of arrows, including the type of hunting broad-head, must be appropriate for the species being hunted. Only hunting broad-heads are permitted, no animal may be hunted with a field or target type point.
- 13** Trained dogs may be used for the tracking of an animal wounded during a hunt. Such dog/s must be under the direct control of the hunter/handler at all times. **A SPECIFIC PERMIT IS REQUIRED TO BRING ANY DOG INTO A NATURE RESERVE** and it is the responsibility of the hunter to obtain such permit before the commencement of the hunt.
- 14** **PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT** of any hunt in any Nature Reserve, all hunters will be expected to present their firearms for a **BASIC INSPECTION AND UNDERGO A SIMPLE MARKSMAN PROFICIENCY TEST**. Bow Hunters will also be required to present their equipment for inspection and will also be required to shoot a proficiency test. Bow hunters must however provide their own targets, including an appropriate platform (butt) to hold the target, for this purpose.
- 15** Hunting may only take place during the period commencing a half an hour before sunrise and ending half an hour after sunset on the same day.
- 16** **NO HUNTING ON SUNDAYS** will be permitted.
- 17** **NO HUNTING AT NIGHT** will be permitted.
- 18** **ALL FIREARM SAFETY PROCEDURES MUST BE ADHERED TO ALL TIMES**; No loaded or cocked firearms may be left unattended at any camp, no cocked firearms may be transported on any vehicle and hunters must ensure that an adequate backstop is present behind any intended target before firing.
- 19** Every hunter or hunting party (at the discretion of the reserve manager) will be provided with a hunting guide (a representative of the respective Nature Reserve). Such guide must be present at any and all times during which hunting takes place in the Nature Reserve and no hunting may occur if the guide is not present.
- 20** The role of the guide mentioned above is entirely regulatory and **SUCH GUIDE MAY NOT BE USED AS A GUN-BEARER, PERSONAL SERVANT, etc.**
- 21** It is the **SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE HUNTER** to ascertain the species and gender of the animal before such animal is hunted. The reserve representative / guide cannot be held responsible for any mistake involving any animal of the incorrect species or gender, which is killed or wounded by any hunter.
- 22** A fine, equal to **100%** of the price indicated for that particular species for that particular year, will be imposed in any and all instances where an animal of the incorrect species or gender is hunted. The same applies to any and all instances where animals, exceeding the number of animals allocated on the hunt package purchased by the hunter, are hunted. **IN ALL SUCH INSTANCES, THE CARCASSES OF THE ANIMAL/S, IN ITS ENTIRETY INCLUDING THE SKIN, CAPE, HEAD, HORNS AND ANY OTHER PART OF THE ANIMAL, WILL ALSO BE FORFEITED AND NEITHER THE HUNTER NOR THE PROFESSIONAL HUNTER/OUTFITTER MAY MAKE ANY CLAIM TO ANY TROPHY PARTS WHATSOEVER OF ANY ANIMAL HUNTED UNDER THE AFOREMENTIONED CIRCUMSTANCES.**
- 23** **ANY ANIMAL WOUNDED BY ANY HUNTER IS DEEMED TO HAVE BEEN HUNTED**. Every effort must be made to recover such wounded animal/s. Such wounded animal/s, if not recovered by the hunter, will be forfeited by the hunter; when the hunter leaves the Nature Reserve.
- 24** Nature Reserve officials may kill any animal wounded by any hunter in the Nature Reserve.

**CONDITIONS OF SALE: HUNTING LOTS AND
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- 25** Nature Reserve personnel **WILL ASSIST THE HUNTER WITH THE SKINNING**, dressing and cleaning of the carcasses of hunted game. **RESERVE PERSONNEL ARE NOT PERMITTED, IN ANY MANNER OR AT ANY TIME, TO ASSIST WITH THE CAPING OR SPECIFIC SKINNING OF ANY TROPHY ANIMAL OR THE PROCESSING OF ANY MEAT.**
- 26** Hunters are responsible for the provision of their **OWN TRANSPORT** while hunting in the Nature Reserve. Such transport must be suitable for travelling on gravel roads and unmade tracks as well as for the conveyance of hunted carcasses.
- 27** The hunter is **RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONVEYANCE OF ALL HUNTED CARCASSES**. Reserve personnel may assist, at the discretion of the Reserve Manager or officiating official, with the conveyance, to the reserve's abattoir, of larger carcasses such as Buffalo, Giraffe and Eland. However, the hunter remains responsible for the condition of the carcass and the skin/trophy of such carcass.
- 28** In instances where specific hunt duration dates are allocated to specific hunt packages, the hunt may only take place during those specified dates and no deviation from this will be permitted, Furthermore, no application, by the hunter, owner of the package or any other person or party, for any deviation from the set hunting dates will be considered in any manner whatsoever by DARDEA. **IF SUCH HUNT IS NOT COMPLETED DURING THE ALLOTTED TIME, THE HUNT WILL BE FORFEITED IN ITS ENTIRETY.**
- 29** In instances where specific dates are not allocated to a specific package, such package must be hunted by the 31st March of the following year. If such hunt is not completed by the aforementioned date, the hunt will be forfeited in its entirety. Furthermore, no application, by the hunter, owner of the package, Professional Hunter / Hunting Outfitter or any other person or party, for any deviation from the set hunting dates will be considered in any manner whatsoever by DARDEA. If such hunt is not completed during the allotted time, the hunt will be forfeited in its entirety.
- 30** Hunters are expected to contact the specific reserve at least **14 DAYS PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT DATE OF THE HUNT TO ARRANGE ACCOMMODATION**, etc. Purchasers of hunt packages to which no specific dates have been allocated are expected to arrange, with the specific reserve manager, the dates of their intended hunt at least **14 DAYS PRIOR TO THE INTENDED COMMENCEMENT DATE.**
- 31** **ALL ANIMALS**, designated as **NON-TROPHY ANIMALS AND ALLOCATED TO SUCH NON-TROPHY HUNTING PACKAGES**, **WILL BE INDICATED TO THE HUNTER BY THE OFFICIAL RESERVE REPRESENTATIVE.**
- 32** Only one group of hunters will be permitted at any one time on all Reserves, unless so indicated by the Reserve Manager.
- 33** A day fee is payable per hunting package per day in all instances where hunters do not make use of reserve accommodation.
- 34** The **USE OF SILENCERS / SUPPRESSORS** is recommended on all firearms and in all of the Provincial Nature Reserves but the use of such is mandatory on Maria Moroka Nature Reserve.
- 35** **HUNTERS MUST ABIDE BY ALL OF THE AFOREMENTIONED RULES AND WITH ALL OTHER RULES AND REGULATIONS SPECIFIC TO THE NATURE RESERVE ON WHICH THE HUNT TAKES PLACE AS WELL AS OBEYING ANY AND ALL REASONABLE INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN TO THE HUNTER BY THE RESERVE MANAGER;**

FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN THE FORFEITURE OF THE HUNT IN ITS ENTIRETY AND PROSECUTION OF THE OFFENDER/S.

Reserve	Closest Town	Description
Caledon Nature Reserve	Wepener	Situated 130km southeast of Bloemfontein on the R701 between Wepener and Smithfield. Closest town are Wepener and Dewetsdorp
Erferis Dam Nature Reserve	Theunissen	Situated 18km east of Theunissen on the Theunissen - Windburg road (R708). From the N1 highway, the turnoff to the reserve lies 20 km west of Windburg.
Gariep Nature Reserve	Gariepdam	Situated 200km south of Bloemfontein adjacent to the Gariep Dam and the small town or Gariepdam (8km to the east of the N1). Road signs indicate the turn-off on the N1.
Koppies Dam Nature Reserve	Koppies	Situated 16km east of the town of Koppies. The town of Koppies lies 55km north of Kroonstad, just off the N1 between Kroonstad and Sasolburg. The roads are well marked.
Maria Moroka Nature Reserve	Thaba N'chu	Situated 90km east of Bloemfontein adjacent to the popular Black Mountain Hotel near the town of Thaba N'chu.
Rustfontein Dam Nature Reserve	Bloemfontein	Situated 50km east of Bloemfontein just off the Bloemfontein/Thaba N'chu road (N8)
Sandveld Nature Reserve	Bloemhof	Situated 200km northwest of Bloemfontein. The reserve is located along the Bloemhof/Hoopstad road (R34), 10 km from Bloemhof and 30 km from Hoopstad.
Seekoeivlei Nature Reserve	Memel	Situated adjacent to the town of Memel in the north eastern Free State.
Soetdoring Nature Reserve	Bloemfontein	Situated on the Bloemfontein- (R700) Bultfontein road 45km from Bloemfontein.
Sterkfontein Dam Nature Reserve	Harrismith	Situated 23km from Harrismith on the Harrismith/Bergville road (R74).
Tussen die Riviere Nature Reserve	Bethulie	Situated in the southern Free State 65km east of the N1 and 15km from Bethulie on the R701. The entrance gate to the reserve is situated on the road between Bethulie and Smithfield (R701) Southern Free State.
Willem Pretorius Nature Reserve	Ventersburg	Situated 30km from Ventersburg and 130km from Bloemfontein. The turn-off to the reserve is clearly indicated on the N1 between Windburg and Ventersburg.

SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE TROPHY CONCESSION HUNT AT SANDVELD NATURE RESERVE

No exceptions to these conditions will be considered and any deviation, whether negligent or willful, from the conditions by the buyer of these packages, or any of their personnel, may result in the hunting actions being suspended or terminated and any monies paid to the State being forfeited.

This hunt in concession are only available until the 31st March 2027. NO EXTENTIONS, FOR ANY REASONS WHATSOEVER BEYOND THE 31ST MARCH 2027, WILL BE CONSIDERED BY DARDEA.

1. The buyer of the lot will be responsible for providing sufficient staff for all skinning, trophy preparation, slaughtering, etc
2. The Sandveld Nature Reserve will only provide a field guide to oversee every hunt, no other staff for skinning, slaughtering etc will be provided by the reserve.
3. The buyer of the lot, or his or her delegate, must confirm availability of the **SANDVELD RESERVE AND FIELD RANGER FOR EACH HUNTING ACTION AT LEAST 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE EXPECTED DATE OF ARRIVAL.** This will avoid conflict between culling actions, etc which will continue on the reserve.
4. The buyer of the lot, or his or her delegate, must confirm availability of accommodation in the reserve for hunting actions at least 2 weeks prior to the expected date of arrival.
5. Only those animals reflected in the hunting lot may be hunted: no other animals may be hunted in the reserve.
6. The reserve **will not be** responsible for any late or “emergency” requests which cannot be honored at short notice.

Please note:

- Hunting only from Mondays to Thursdays
- All skinning tools and equipment (knives, saws etc) to be provided by the buyer of the package.
- No personnel of the buyer will be accommodated in the reserve (including abattoir)
- Accommodation can be booked at the Resort.

Special Conditions for 2026 Auction:

1. Hunting and Culling will be conducted strictly under Foot and Mouth protocols.
2. All biltong hunts: Heads, Horns, skins and intestines to be left on premises.
3. Vehicles to be treated on entry.
4. Permit Officials will be on site to facilitate extension permits for hunting.
5. Vleissentraal Bloemfontein will be in charged of refundable deposits.
6. Vleissentraal will act on behalf of DARDEA as Auctioneers but are not responsible for delivery of lots bought on auction from DARDEA.

1. The Sale by auction is subject to a reserve price, unless specifically stated to the contrary by the auctioneer.
2. 24. If the Auctioneer agrees to facilitate the purchase of the assets by paying an amount equal to the purchase price to the Seller before the Buyer makes payment to the Auctioneer ("the Payment Terms Agreement"), then the following shall apply:

26. 28. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION (POPIA):

- 28.2. If the parties process personal information, they will:
- apply reasonable security measures.

 - treat personal information as confidential and not disclose it to third parties without written consent.
- 28.3. The Auctioneer has the right to audit the parties' operations and access the necessary equipment and information to ensure compliance and investigate any security breaches.
- 28.4. In the event of a security breach, the affected party must immediately notify and provide information such as the date, nature of the breach, responsible persons (if known), and protection measures.
- 28.5. The parties will indemnify each other against any loss or damage resulting from non-compliance with POPIA and appoint an Information Officer as required.

31. In the event where a Buyer allows another person to purchase on his or her buyer's number, the registered Buyer shall be liable for payment of such purchases. No bid by an unregistered Buyer will be accepted by the auctioneer and the Buyer will have no claim to any of the assets allegedly purchased by him.
32. Until all amounts owing by the Buyer have been paid in full, the Buyer hereby:

VLEISSENTRAAL BLOEMFONTEIN (Edms) Bpk – Registrasie no 1999/023878/07 (Hierna die “Maatskappy” genoem)

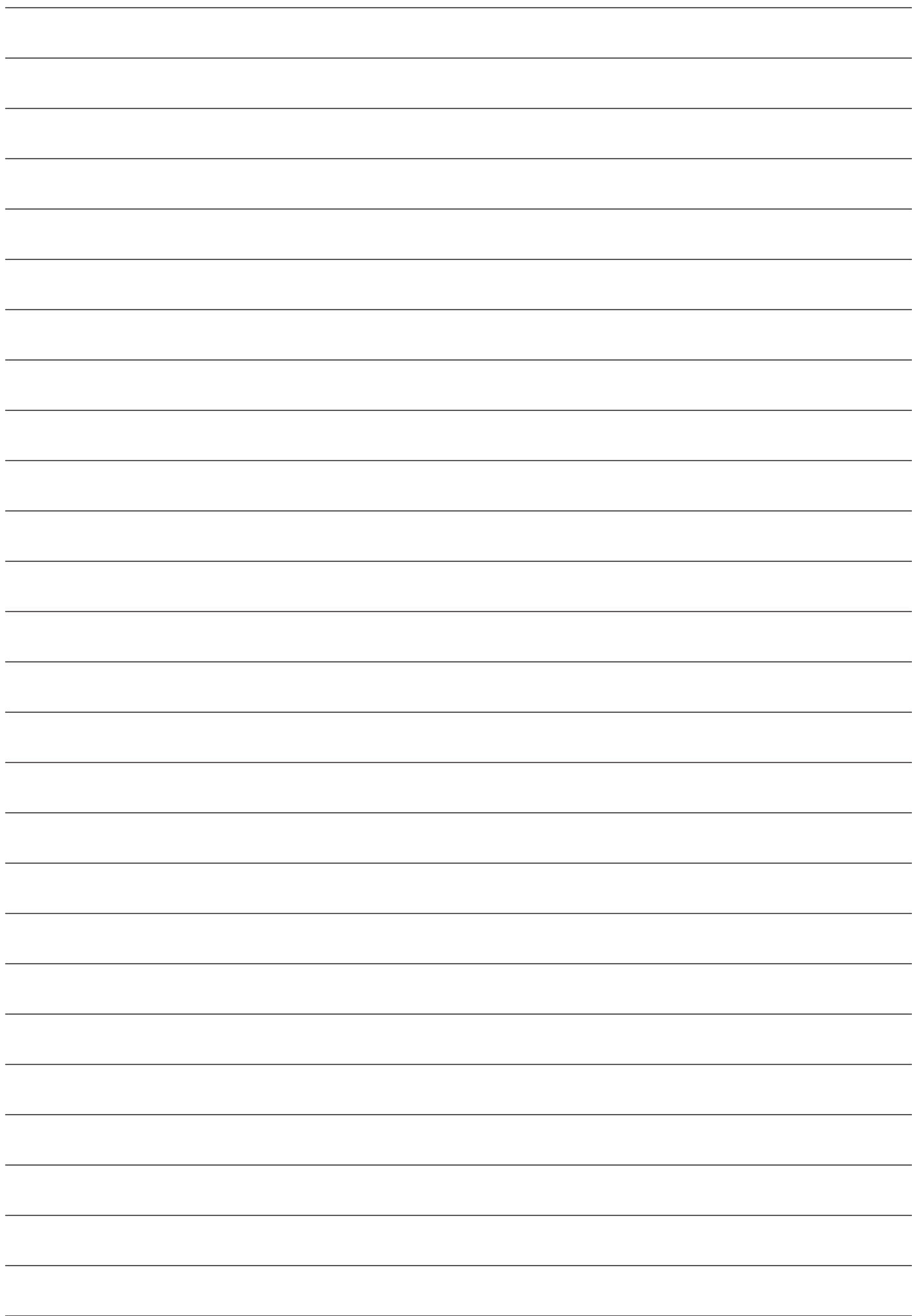

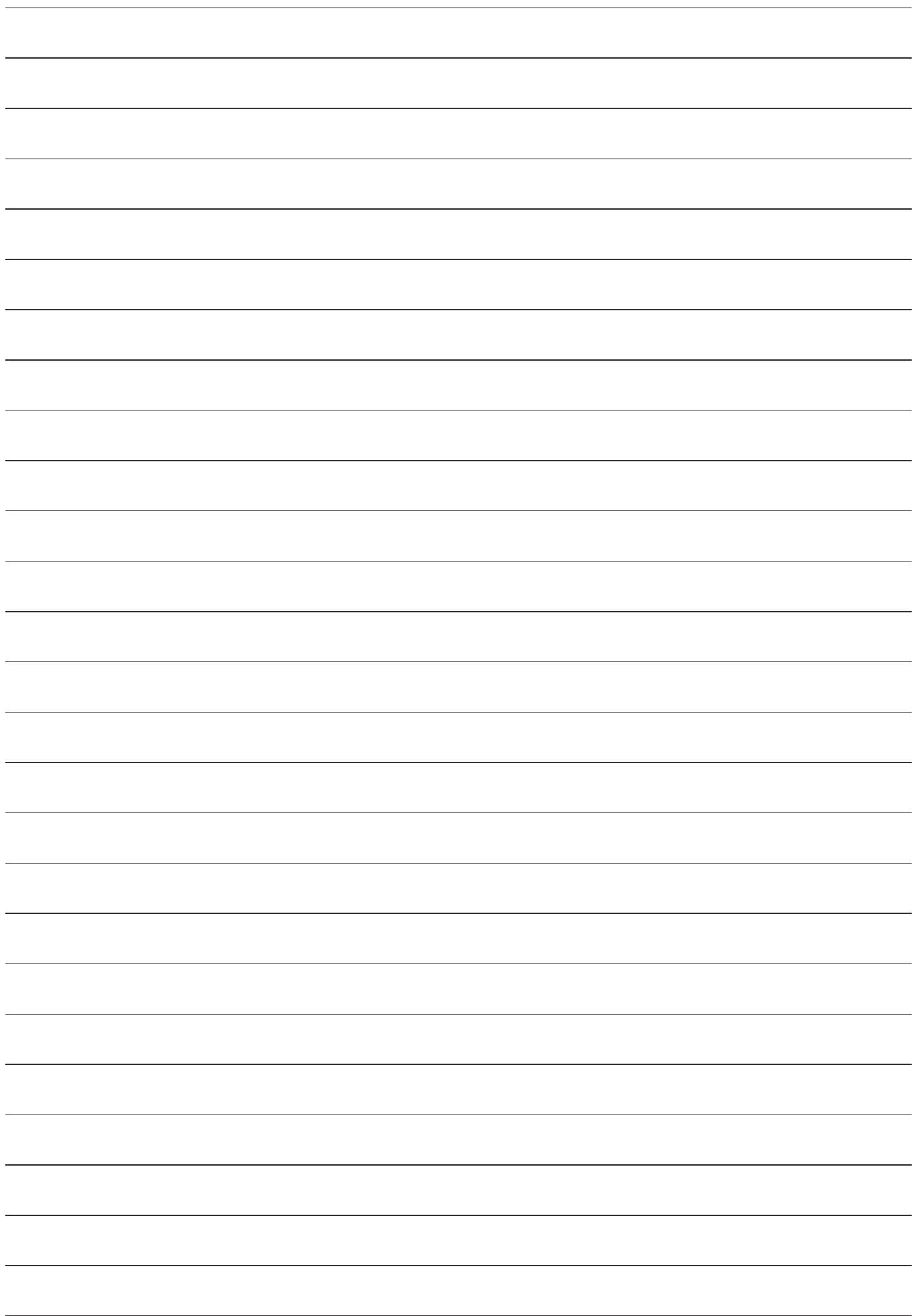

 - 6.3. No Payment Terms Agreement **shall** be valid unless reduced to writing and duly signed on behalf of the Company. The facilitation of any sale by the Company as referred to in this paragraph 6 **shall** be strictly subject to the terms and conditions of the Payment Terms Agreement.
 - 6.4. In the event of any conflict between the contents of this document and the Payment Terms Agreement, the provisions of the Payment Terms Agreement **shall** prevail.
 - 6.5. No application for credit as defined in section 8 of the National Credit Act, Act 34 of 2005, **will** be received or considered by the Company.
7. The **Seller** warrants against the Company that the assets are free of patent and latent defects and that any right or claim ceded to the Company in terms of these terms and conditions is free of any defect or right of deduction or set-off, and that the said right or claim is fully and immediately enforceable against the Buyer.
8. The Buyer **shall** not be entitled to withhold payment of the purchase price to the Company as a result of any possible or pending claim that he may have against the Seller on the grounds of misrepresentation or for any other reason whatsoever.
9. In the event where Buyers must register at an Auction, and such a registered Buyer **allows** another person to purchase on his buyers card, the registered Buyer **shall** be **liable** for payment of such purchases. No bid by an unregistered Buyer **will** be accepted by the Company and the Buyer **will** have no claim to any of the assets **allegedly** purchased by him.
10. Subject to any reserve placed on any of the assets by the **Seller**, and the provisions of clause 14 and 15 below, the Buyer at any sale **shall** be the highest bidder indicated by the Company's auctioneer by the fall of the hammer or by such other means as he may select.
11. **All** assets **shall** immediately after the bid being knocked down, be deemed to have been delivered to the Buyer. Notwithstanding delivery, the Buyer **shall** not be entitled to remove any purchased assets unless the total amount reflected on the Company's tax invoice in respect of such assets has been paid in **full**.
12. **All** profit, loss or risk in the assets **will** pass to the Buyer once it has been delivered to the Buyer who **shall** at this own risk and expense remove it from the sale venue, subject to 11 above.
13. Should a carriage contractor remove any assets from the sale venue on instruction of the Company, the contractor **will** be deemed an agent of the Buyer who accepts **all** costs and risks connected with such removal.
14. The auction **shall** take place under the exclusive control of the Company. The Company reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to refuse the bid of any person, to regulate the bidding, to indicate the highest bidder and to vary the order of the sale at any time without giving reasons therefor. If the auctioneer suspects that a bidder has not made a bona fide bid, or is unable to pay the purchase price or has not made satisfactory arrangements for payment of the purchase price, he may refuse to accept the bid of such bidder or accept it provisionally, until the bidder has satisfied him that he is in position to pay the purchase price or that he has made satisfactory arrangements for payment thereof. On refusal of a bid under such circumstances the assets may immediately be re-auctioned.
15. In the event of a dispute arising amongst the bidders, the assets in dispute **shall**, at the sole discretion of the Company, be re-auctioned.
16. The Company **shall** not be liable for loss or damages caused to, or sustained in respect of any action by, the Company or its helpers, employees or agents, notwithstanding an undertaking to care for or attend to, to despatch or deliver the assets. **All** assets are sold to the Buyer "voetstoots" and the Company **shall** not be liable for any defects, latent or otherwise which might exist with or without the knowledge of the Company.

17. The Buyer **shall**, prior to the sale, ascertain whether there are any defects in the assets and any bid by a Buyer **shall** be considered as acceptance of the assets with any patent or latent defects in their condition at the time of sale.
18. The Company reserves the right to refuse any cheque as payment.
19. Notwithstanding delivery, ownership of the purchased assets **will** not pass to the Buyer until the **full** purchase price **plus** interest, if payable, is paid.
20. Until **all** amounts owing by the Buyer have been paid in **full**, the Buyer hereby:
 - 20.1. **irrevocably** undertakes to identify the purchased assets in such a manner that he can at any time identify and indicate the assets deemed to be the property of, and **pledged** to, the Company,
 - 20.2. grants the Company access at **all** reasonable times to the premises where the assets are stored for the purposes of perfecting its **pledge** and exercising any other rights in terms of these terms and conditions.
21. The Buyer and the **Seller** hereby consent to the jurisdiction of the Magistrate's Court in terms of Section 45 of the Act on Magistrate Court (Act 32 of 1944 as amended) for any action instituted by the Company against the Buyer **although** the Company is entitled to institute litigation in any competent Court.
22. The entries made in the Company's auction **roll shall** be prima facie evidence of the transaction and **shall** be binding on the **Seller** and the Buyer.
23. A certificate issued by a Manager of the Company, whose appointment and authority **shall** not be necessary to prove, **shall** be prima facie proof of monies owing by the Buyer to the **Seller** or the Company.
24. Any person who purchases on behalf of a principal must furnish the Company with a power of attorney prior to the commencement of the sale failing which he **will** personally be **liable** for payment of any purchases made by him. The person bidding on behalf of or signing any document on behalf of the Buyer pursuant to a successful bid thereby binds himself personally as co-principal debtor with the Buyer for payment of the purchase price and personally guarantees **all** the obligations of the Buyer under these terms and conditions.
25. Any indulgence granted by the Company to the Buyer or the **Seller** **will** not prejudice the rights of the Company in terms of these conditions and such indulgence **will** not constitute an amendment or waiver or novation of these terms and conditions.
26. **All** persons entering the sale venue do so at their own risk and the Company **shall** not be liable for any injuries, damages or losses of any nature whatsoever.
27. The Company reserves the right to amend these conditions of sale in writing.
28. Any assets entered or offered for sale are subject to payment by the **Seller** of the **Seller** of the agreed commission, or in absence of agreement the usual commission by the **Seller** to the Company at the rate customarily charged by the Company from time to time, whether the assets are sold at the auction or thereafter, or at any time thereafter by private treaty. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, commission **shall** become due and payable by the **Seller** upon the fall of the hammer or upon the entering into of any private treaty involving the **Seller's** said assets, whichever date is the earlier, and notwithstanding any breach on the part of the **Seller**.
29. In the event of registered vehicles being sold by the Company, it is a specific condition that the Company does not guarantee the information regarding the vehicles and does not undertake to furnish the transfer documents and registration certificates to the Buyer. The Buyer **shall** be responsible to obtain the aforementioned documents and **shall** not be entitled to withhold payment due to a failure on the part of either the Company or the **Seller** to furnish the documents.
30. Any agreement contrary to these conditions of sale **shall** not be binding unless it is confirmed in writing and signed by a Manager of the Company.
31. Should the Purchaser fail to pay the purchase price, **Vleissenstraat Bloemfontein shall** be entitled in its discretion to:
 - 31.1 claim from the Purchaser interest at the maximum interest rate from date of purchase until date of settlement; and/or
 - 31.2 repossess the assets, to resell it at the risk of the defaulting Purchaser who **shall** be liable for all costs involved with the resale and also be liable of any damages sustained. The Purchaser **will** not be entitled to any profit that may arise from the resale; or
 - 31.3 institute legal proceedings for the payment of the amount owing or for the return of the assets in which event the conditions of Clause 13.2 will apply; and
 - 31.4 recover any legal costs calculated at the Attorney/Client tariff as well as collection costs.
32. Game Catalogue Sales: **All** profit, loss and risk in the assets **will** pass to the Purchaser once it has been delivered to the Purchaser who **shall** at own expense remove it from the venue agreed between the **Seller** and Purchaser.
33. Game Auction Sales (Bomas): **All** assets **shall** immediately after bid being knocked down, be considered as delivered to the Purchaser and **all** profit, loss or risk in the assets **will** pass to the Purchaser who **shall** at own expense remove it from the sale venue. Buyers of game kept in bomas must take possession and remove such game within 48 hours after sale. Should a buyer fail to remove and take delivery within the fixed time after the sale, he/she **will** forfeit **all** monies already paid to the **Seller**.
